Hurricane Matthew was a Category 5 Atlantic hurricane with windspeeds which reached 165mph causing catastrophic damage and a humanitarian crisis in Haiti in October 2016. It's over a year since Marcelin and his three daughters lost their home, but they're still living in a 2x2m windowless concrete block. Marcelin has raised his three daughters alone. They've endured some of the worst natural disasters on earth. They're not just survivors. They're fighters. But they're only so strong. They won't survive the next hurricane without help.
