Gazebo Gathering in Kinross showcases local talent Saturday 4 September from 12 noon-7.30pm

This year's Gazebo Gathering not only has two great tribute acts it also showcases a fantastic line-up of local talent - **Beautiful By Design, Mama Kin, Well Known Strangers, Handle With Care and The Gary Sutherland Ceilidh Band.**

This must-see family music festival is on Saturday 4th September in the grounds of the stunning Kinross House – make sure you have that date in your diary. Tickets are selling-out fast so make sure you buy them soon. The festival is run by Kinross Local Events Organisation (KLEO). KLEO was formed 3 years ago and has organised many local events and activities.

Beautiful By Design are a five piece pop-rock outfit from the East of Scotland. In the short time since their formation, their uniquely upbeat but sombre style has earned them rave reviews and an army of loyal fans, including legendary radio presenter Jim Gellatly. "A band that just seems to have the knack of creating great little pop songs that you want to sing along to" - Jim Gellatly, BBC Radio Scotland.

Mama Kin is the winner of the Battle of the Bands at the Kinross High School. Their motto is, "Loose and Colourful," which, to them, means let go onstage, put on a great show, involve the crowd and, above all, enjoy the music they play!

High School Band **Well Known Strangers** will open this year's festival, a four piece band of local talent who won the notorious 'K-Factor' this year at the Kinross High School.

Blue Fuse is another four piece High School Band who will return this year after a successful performance at last year's Gazebo Gathering.

Handle With Care, also making a come-back, are a local acoustic based duo (both playing the guitar) with a strong rock influence incorporating some folk and blues influences.

And to make sure the day goes off with a twirl, **The Gary Sutherland Ceilidh Band** will have everybody dancing in front of the main stage.

Headlining the festival are two fantastic tribute acts – **THEM BEATLES** and a **DIVA tribute act** (featuring Madonna, Shakira, Shania Twain and Lady Gaga).

As well as the great music there will be plenty of fun for all the family. Whilst mum and dad relax on the lawn the kids can take advantage of the various children's activities. A variety of Food and Drink stalls will be available on site.

Tickets

Tickets are available from the Scottish e-Bike Centre (103 High Street Kinross) or on-line at www.kleo.org.uk: £17.50 for adults (16 and over on 4th of September), £10.00 for a child (15 and under) and £45.00 for a family ticket (two adults and two children).

Gazebos

You don't have to own a gazebo to attend the event but if you have one, bring it along and you can pitch it for only £1.00. However, spaces are limited so they will be allocated on a first come first served basis when buying tickets (pre-book voucher with ticket).

If you don't own a Gazebo don't worry, KLEO will be hiring out a limited number of front row "Premiere Gazebos" for only £30. These gazebos will already have been set up for you in a prime pitch location in the first two front lines. Other already pitched gazebos "Secondary Gazebos" can be hired for £20.
